Z Group – Considered level 9

The “Z” stands for “Zero Brains”. This group skis **Black and Double Black Diamond slopes**. They want to challenge themselves on the most difficult slopes Big Sky has to offer. When free skiing, the Z Group is above tree line on Black Diamond slopes over 50% of the time. Low light, steeper off piste terrain, and moguls don’t phase this group, any time any place is their motto. The Z Group confidently skis all runs off Challenger and the Tram including Marx and Lenin.

N Group – Considered level 8

The “N” stands for “Nearly Zero Brains”. This group skis all **Blue and many of the Black Diamond slopes**. They are confident skiing off piste in powder and moguls. The N Group frequently skis the Bowl, easier runs off of Challenger, Liberty Bowl, and glades. They prefer to tackle the harder black runs when the lights good and it feels right. It does not mean that they ski these runs occasionally, but instead try to ski them frequently with confidence. This group’s intensity is a notch down from the Z Group skiers. They are solid Blue level and Black Level skiers.

E Group – Considered Level 7

The “E” Stands for Easing into Skiing the Mountain”. These people are **comfortable on all groomed Blue Level slopes and want to explore the off piste**. They are interested in developing their skills and comfort level in bumps, moguls, powder and ungroomed slopes. The groups will target to get “off piste” as often as possible and expand knowledge and experience with the 80% of the Resort terrain which is not machine groomed. This category usually has several levels within it. Typically, several E Groups will try venturing into the Bowl, Challenger and other Black diamond slopes when the conditions are right and the light is ideal.

W Group – Considered levels 5 and 6

The “W” stands for “Wanabees”. This group is for **Green Level Skiers** already comfortable on Mr. K. People in this group are eager to learn, with a sincere desire to be able to ski on the more difficult Blue Level slopes. This is not a “**learn-to-ski**” group, but skiers desiring to enhance their current skiing skills, style and confidence. They will venture into some Blue level and ungroomed terrain to broaden their experience.

G Group – Considered level 6 to 8

The “G” stands for Groovin Smoothies Group. This group skis **mainly Groomed Blue terrain**. Groomed is the important word to remember here, people in this group are mainly interested in style and form on smooth groomed terrain. There will be limited exposure to off piste. On fresh powder days however, the Groovin Smoothies may venture into the deeper snow to experience Big Sky’s “White Gold”.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF INHERENT DANGERS AND RISKS OF MOUNTAIN SPORTS

I acknowledge that skiing, snowboarding, which means any activity that involves sliding, racing gates or jumping on snow or ice, zipping, jumping on a bungee trampoline, snowshoeing, involves inherent dangers and risks that are part of the sport and cannot



be eliminated including: changing weather conditions; snow conditions as they exist or as they may change, including ice, hardpack, powder, packed powder, wind pack, corn snow, crust, slush, cut-up snow, and machine-made snow; avalanches, except on open, designated ski trails; collisions with natural surface or subsurface conditions, such as bare spots, forest growth, rocks, stumps, streambeds, cliffs, trees, and other natural objects; collisions with lift towers, signs, posts, fences, enclosures, hydrants, water pipes, or other artificial structures and their components; variations in steepness or terrain, whether natural or the result of slope design, snowmaking, or snow grooming operations, including but not limited to roads, freestyle terrain, ski jumps, catwalks, and other terrain modifications; collisions with clearly visible or plainly marked equipment, including but not limited to lift equipment, snowmaking equipment, snow grooming equipment, trail maintenance equipment, and snowmobiles, whether or not the equipment is moving; collisions with other skiers; the failure of a skier to ski within that skier's ability; skiing in a closed area or skiing outside the ski area boundary as designated on the ski area trail map; and restricted visibility caused by snow, wind, fog, sun, or darkness. I acknowledge these activities may be physically or emotionally demanding. I affirm my (or my child's) health is good, and that I (or my child) am (is) not under a physician's care for any undisclosed condition that might endanger my (or my child's) health or that of other participants. I recognize the inherent risk of injury or disability in this activity. I understand that it is required to wear a helmet during this activity and that a Petzl climbing helmet is available for my use. **I accept all legal responsibility for injury or damage of any kind to the extent that the injury or damage results from inherent dangers and risks of skiing.**

I agree that I have a duty to ski at all times in a manner that avoids injury to the skier and others and to be aware of the inherent dangers and risks of skiing. The skier shall: know the range of the skier's ability and safely ski within the limits of that ability and the skier's equipment so as to negotiate any section of terrain or ski slope and trail safely and without injury or damage; know that the skier's ability may vary because of ski slope and trail changes caused by weather, grooming changes, or skier use; maintain control of speed and course so as to prevent injury to the skier or others; abide by the requirements of the skier responsibility code that is published by the national ski areas association; obey all posted or other warnings and instructions of the ski area operator; read the ski area trail map and be aware of its contents.
