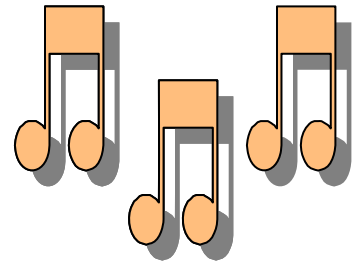


# Season Events
